Bay Point Homicide Investigation

This morning at about 12:58, Muir Station deputy sheriffs were dispatched to a "shots fired" call on the 2100 block of Mendocino Drive in Bay Point.

Deputies arrived on scene and found a person suffering from gunshot wounds in a front yard. Deputies immediately performed life-saving measures until the fire department and an ambulance arrived. The person was later pronounced deceased. He is not being identified at this time.

Deputies learned that two other gunshot victims transported themselves to a local hospital and are being treated for non-life-threatening wounds.

Detectives from the Homicide Unit and crime lab personnel arrived at the scene.

The investigation is ongoing.
